## Speaker: Joseph Smolinski, Montecito Cemetery



It was a pleasure to have Joe Smolinski back with us again. His job has kept him extremely busy over the past year, causing Joe to miss several meetings. Joe said that he missed the club, and is renewing his membership today.

He updated the club on the Montecito Cemetery, which is part of Service Corporation International (SCI) that manages over 15,000 cemeteries nationwide. Montecito was established in 1920 and has witnessed tremendous growth over the years. The cemetery has handled from 50 to 1000 burials per year. It has sufficient property to handle funerals for the next 200 years. A portion of the property was recently sold to developers for a housing tract. Another portion was set aside for a Catholic Cemetery( Our Lady Queen of Peace). The small chapel, which seats only 95 guests, is going to be replaced with a 14,000 sq.ft. full-service facility. This is the last structure of this size to be built by SCI due to the increasing preference for cremation.

Montecito is unique in that it borders on three cities and serves a very diverse population.

At the conclusion of his talk, Joe advised us to plan ahead. The interest of the group was shown by the many questions.
